“FREE Residential Landfill Week”

The Town is no longer picking up items from back alleys except for trees and compost.

As only trees and compost are allowed to be placed in back alleys, this is a great opportunity for you to remove all other items (such as couches, appliances, renovation materials, etc.) from your back alleys without paying fees at the landfill.

Therefore, the Town of Biggar is hosting a “Free Residential Landfill Week” from Monday, September 17th through Saturday, September 22, 2018. The Landfill hours of operation are Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday from 10 am to 8 pm.

You may bring your household waste to the Town of Biggar landfill for free during our Free Residential Landfill Week. At all other times, landfill fees will apply.

Commercial and industrial properties are not included in the free landfill week, but we encourage everyone to participate in the cleaning up our community.

You must be a resident of the Town of Biggar and proof of residency will be required (ex. Driver’s license, water bill, etc.).

Items that can be dropped off for free include: furniture, grass clippings, tree branches, regular household garbage, and appliances (that do not contain Freon). All appliances that contain Freon will be subject to the regular \$25.00 charge per item.

All hazardous materials are not accepted. Hazardous materials include: tires, paint, TV’s, computers, printers, oil, oil jugs, and oil filters.
