



Paint a Hydrant

The Town of Biggar Paint a Hydrant Program!

The Town of Biggar is pleased to announce our new Paint a Hydrant Program. Interested artists are allowed to adopt one, or more, fire hydrants within the Town of Biggar limits and create appropriate characters or designs for them. Our goal for this program is to embrace and support the local artistic talents within Biggar by displaying creative character artwork throughout our community. Although there is no specific theme for the Paint a Hydrant program, artists are encouraged to design their characters with aspects of the surrounding environment and neighborhoods (Example: a robber by the police station, a hockey player by the rink, doctor or nurse by the hospital, firefighter or Dalmatian dog by the fire hall). Artists are responsible for providing their own materials. Please note that existing artwork cannot be painted over.

PROGRAM DETAILS

How to participate in this program

- Fill out the application/design proposal (page 2)
- Include the location of which hydrant(s) you would like to paint (see attached map for number reference)
- Submit the required forms to townoffice@townofbiggar.com or drop them off at the Town Office.
- The Town of Biggar will contact you once your application has been approved.

How should I begin painting after receiving town approval?

- Remove all dirt, mud, loose paint, and other debris from the hydrant before painting.
- The Town of Biggar will supply the oil-based primer needed to ensure the paint adheres better.
- Protect the immediate area around the hydrant from paint stains.
- Use high quality, oil-based enamel paint for metal.

What is prohibited on the hydrants?

- Inappropriate words, advertisement, political messages, etc.
- Glued or attached objects
- Camouflage or designs that significantly reduce hydrant visibility
- **Try to avoid using dark colors or a lot of white as they reduce hydrant visibility.**

Once I have finished painting my hydrant, what should I do?

- Sign the back of the hydrant with your name
- Notify the Town of Biggar via email to townoffice@townofbiggar.com with a photo of the completed hydrant.

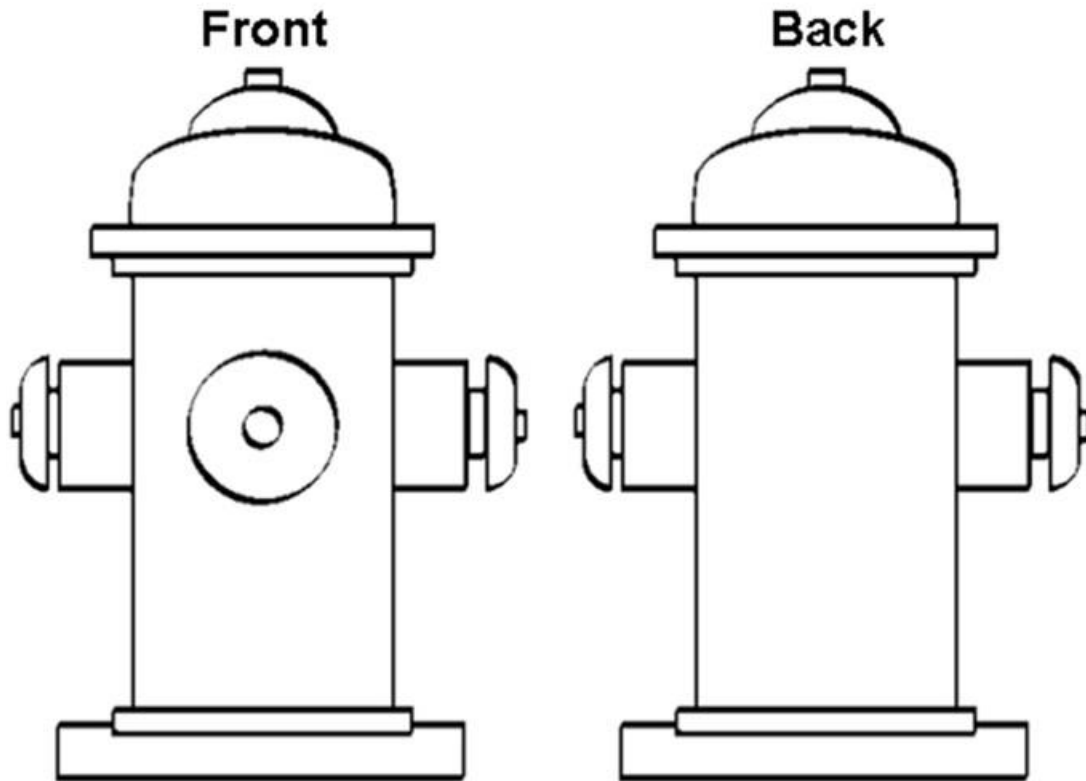

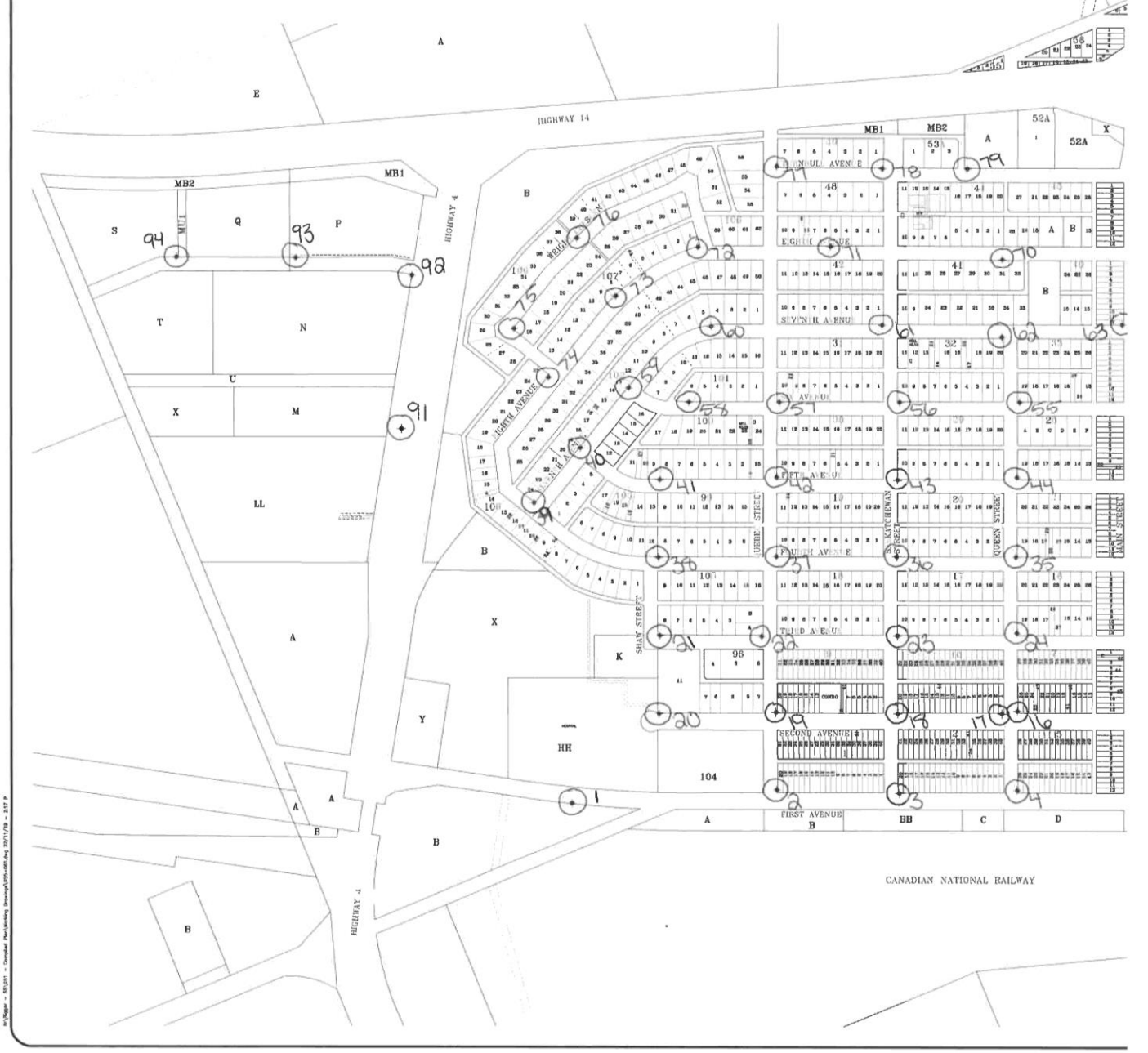

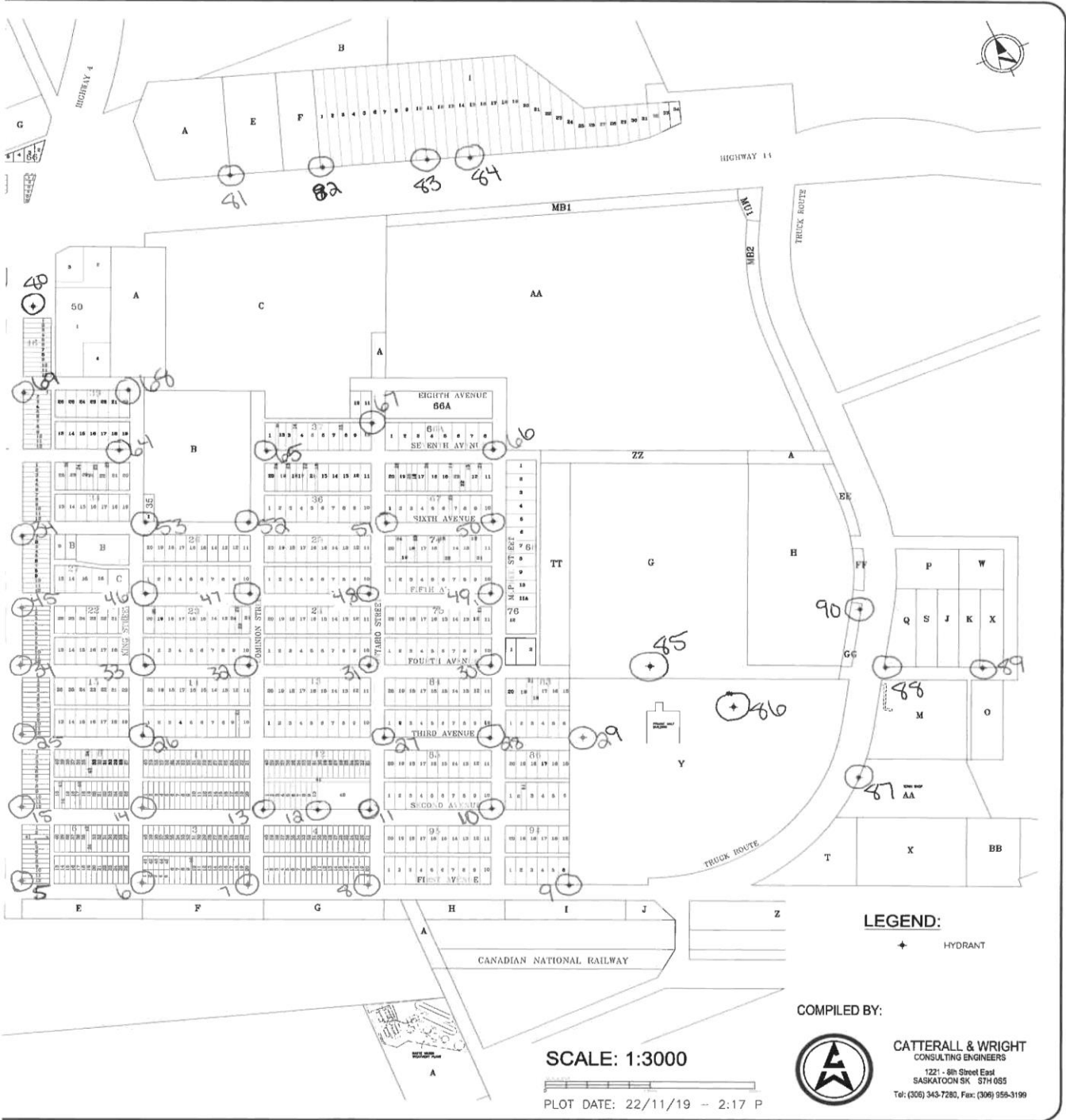
