SIDEWALK SNOW REMOVAL POLICY

1. Residents, Businesses and Institutions are encouraged to clean the sidewalks on the frontage and flankage of their private property in order that residents can utilize the sidewalks during winter months.
2. In areas where sidewalk cleaning is essential to accommodate high pedestrian traffic areas, the Town may, if the sidewalks are not cleaned, clean the sidewalks that are established as priorities in the policy.
3. The priority sidewalks to be cleaned after snowstorms are as follows:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
1. 2 nd Avenue West (both sides)	Main Street	Hospital Turn Around
2. 3 rd Avenue West (South side)	Main Street	Shaw Street
3. 5 th Avenue East (North side)	Main Street	King Street
4. 6 th Avenue East (both sides)	Main Street	King Street
5. 6 th Avenue East (North side)	King Street	Dominion Street

4. The balance of the sidewalks in the Town may be cleaned by the Town, time permitting, in the manner that the Town Foreman directs.
5. Sidewalk cleaning priorities will come second to opening traffic routes.
