

Removal of Recreational Vehicles and Watercraft

An annual reminder that as per Bylaw No. 17-790, all recreational vehicles and watercraft must be removed from the street by:

September 30th, 2023

Any recreational vehicles and/or watercraft remaining on the street after Sept 30th will be subject to bylaw enforcement. We thank you for your cooperation with this seasonal transition.

Fall Clean-Up

Landfill tipping charges will be FREE* for Town of Biggar residents, from:

September 16 - 30
Mon, Wed, Fri, Sat.
10am - 8pm

*\$25.00 fee for deep freezers, fridges, & AC units still apply. Commercial landfill fees still apply.

Street Sweeping

Street Sweeping will start in October. Please be alert for signs requesting all vehicles to be removed from the street during targeted sweeping in your area.
